

# Sequoia 4-H Meeting Minutes

## October 9, 2019

The October meeting of Sequoia 4-H Club was called to order by Bailey Glashan at 7:05 PM on October 9, 2019 at the YAL Center in Rohnert Park. The flags were presented by Elizabeth and Izabella McClintock.
